Non - EU self-sponsored citizens

Foreign applicants who wish to apply for studies must upload their files to the online admission platform, which may be accessed via the link below:

The application session runs from **05.05.2025 – 20.06.2025**

The file processing fee is 300 euros for the Medicine bachelor study program. For the rest of the bachelor and master study programs the file processing fee is 100 euro. The file processing fee must be paid before the application file is submitted.

The admission colloquium fee for PhD studies is 290 euro and must be paid before the application file is submitted.

After the submission of the application files, the candidates will automatically receive an email of confirmation of receipt which also contains the **registration code** of the sent file. **We do not process incomplete application files.**

After the registration period, all candidates will sustain an online English language proficiency test organized by our university. The dates and hours of the tests will be posted on our website by using the registration codes. Therefore, it is the candidate's responsibility to check our website and see when they are programmed to take the online test.

The results of the test will be posted on our website, using the registration codes.

The minimum level of English language proficiency accepted is B1. Those who will obtain a lower score will not be admitted for studies at our university.

Most of our study programs are taught in the Romanian language, so, the candidates have two possibilities:

1. to prove that they are proficient in the Romanian language by submitting a Romanian Language Proficiency Certificate or passing a Romanian language proficiency test;
2. to apply for the Preparatory Year of Romanian Language and Civilization available for foreign students at the Faculty of Letters and Communication Sciences. This means that they will study the Romanian language for an entire academic year for their bachelor's studies, and 6 months for master's, postgraduate, and Ph.D. studies. If the candidate wants to attend this course, they must check the **YES** option on the Application Form (second page, Section II *Studies Applied in Romania*).

The candidates who applied for study programs which organize admission exams, will be contacted, by email, by our admission committee which will communicate the date and hour of the exam.

The admission exams results will be posted on our website by using the registration codes.

***For the Medicine bachelor study program** (6 years) the admitted candidates who pass the admission exam will have to confirm their place, by paying in advance 3000 euro. **This sum is non-refundable.** The candidates will pay the rest of the annual tuition fee after the release of the letter of acceptance issued by the Romanian Ministry of Education.

The rest of the admitted candidates from the other study programs will pay the annual tuition fee after the release of the letter of acceptance issue by the Romanian Ministry of Education.



The study fee paid for the preparatory year (or the first year, for those who do not follow the preparatory year) is not refunded to the admitted candidate.

As an exception, if the visa application is rejected, the tuition fee is partially refundable. In this case, 300 euros from the study fee will be retained by the Ștefan cel Mare University of Suceava, representing the coverage of expenses arising from the admission process, the bank commissions and the bearing of administrative expenses.

For the Medicine bachelor study program, the entire sum of 3000 euro paid in advance will be retained by the Ștefan cel Mare University of Suceava.

Enrolment Conditions:

The enrolment is done in person. The candidates must sign the study contract and bring the study documents in original.

Accommodation

Because the institution has a limited number of accommodation places for international students, the sooner you arrive in Suceava, the more chances you will have to obtain accommodation. Accommodation costs around **150 euros** per month.

Please note that the tuition fee does not include the cost of accommodation.
