

Policy regarding tuition fee refunds for non-EU self-financing citizens studying in Romania, including those from countries outside the European Economic Area and the Swiss Confederation

1. Purpose

This policy applies to non-EU self-financing citizens studying in Romania, including those from countries outside the European Economic Area and the Swiss Confederation.

- 2. Refunding terms:
- a. The application-processing fee is 100 euros.
- b. The application processing fee for the Medicine program (6-year duration) is 300 euros.
- c. The fee for the preliminary practical examination for doctorate admissions is 290 euros.
- d. For the Medicine program (6-year duration), candidates need to make an advance payment of 3000 euros within 5 days of the publication of admission results to secure a place.
- e. Enrollment costs are included in the tuition fee, payable subsequent to the issuance of the acceptance letter by the relevant ministry. The tuition fee paid for the preparatory year or the first year (for those not enrolling in the preparatory year) is non-refundable to the admitted candidate.
- f. Exceptionally, if the visa application is rejected, the tuition fee will be partially refunded. USV will retain 300 euros from the tuition fee to cover admission expenses, as well as those related to bank fees and administrative costs.
- g. USV will retain the tuition fee advance payment from applicants for the 6-year Medicine program.
- h. Refunds will be processed exclusively to the original bank account from which the payment was made.
